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Key points raised through the C2 + TPM5 partners answers and quality recommendations for next steps

Meeting Content:

- **Training Content:** the meeting helped for the improvement of the Training Content, not only concerning the material, but mainly to reinforce a common understanding of the final deliverable content level expectations. From some partners, too much time was spent on the E-learning part, nevertheless it was clearly relevant to cover remaining question to achieve the expected quality of the final delivery.
- **Pilot Training:** it appeared partners differences in organizing their local pilot training. It will have clear impact in the evaluation of achieved results.
- **Future planning and Sustainability:** The time spent on the dissemination actions was perceived as not efficient, some partners pinpointed the lack of perspective of relevant impact for preparing the sustainability of the results. It should be covered during the preparation of the pilot trainings to promote the project results impact for the future.





Key points raised through the C2 + TPM5 partners answers

Future planning and Sustainability:

- The time spent on the dissemination actions was perceived as not efficient, some partners pinpointed the lack of perspective of relevant impact for preparing the sustainability of the results. It should be covered during the preparation of the pilot trainings to promote the project results impact for the future.

Meeting organisation:

- Meeting organization is still well appreciated by partners. The face-to-face meeting was very helpful to build better ties between the Partners
- Partners appreciated the preparations made by the host (Luca) to offer as good conditions and atmosphere for the meeting as it was possible under the circumstances (covid restrictions).

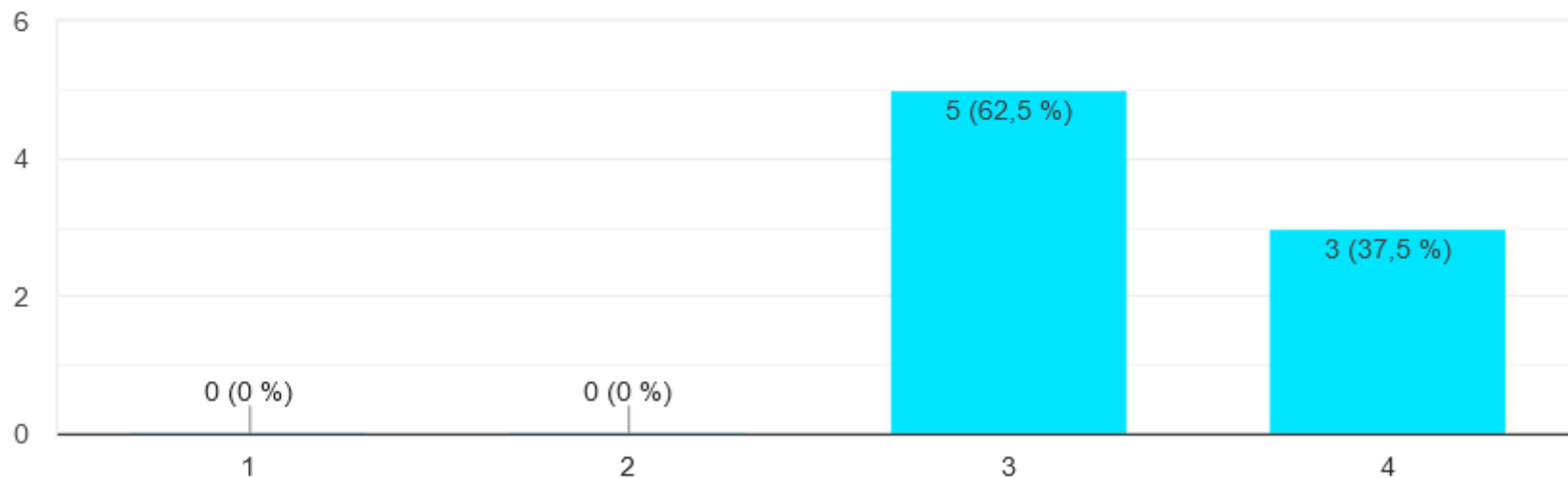
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Q1: After the 3 days Training, How did you find this C2 Training Sessions useful to achieve the expected results of the INTEREST Project?

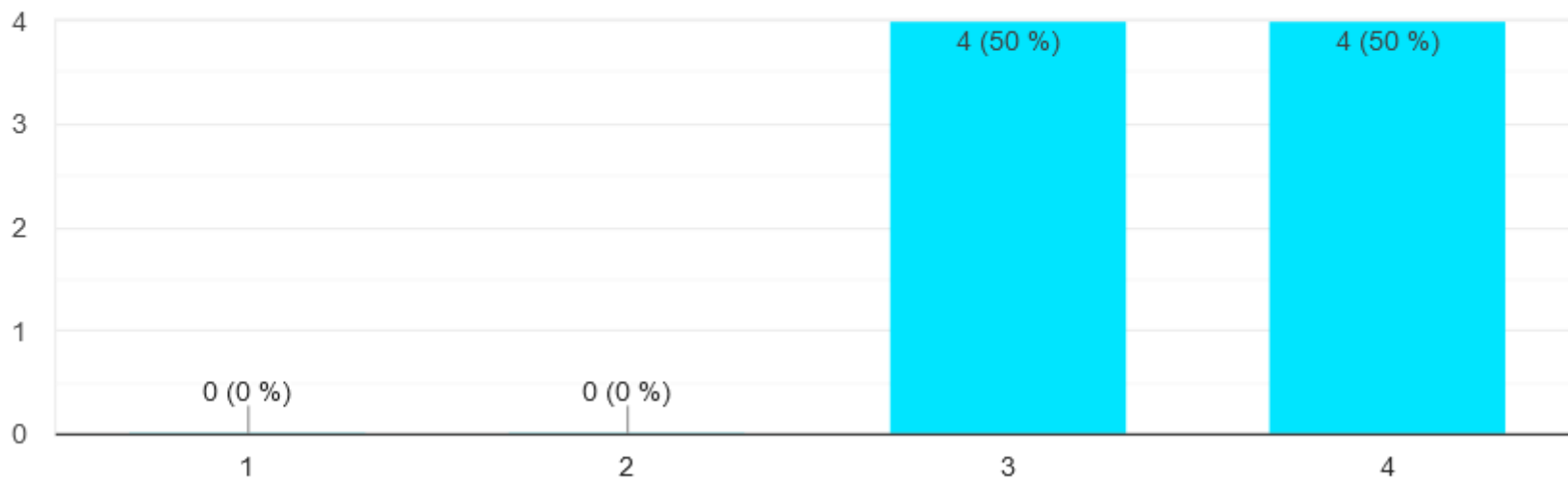

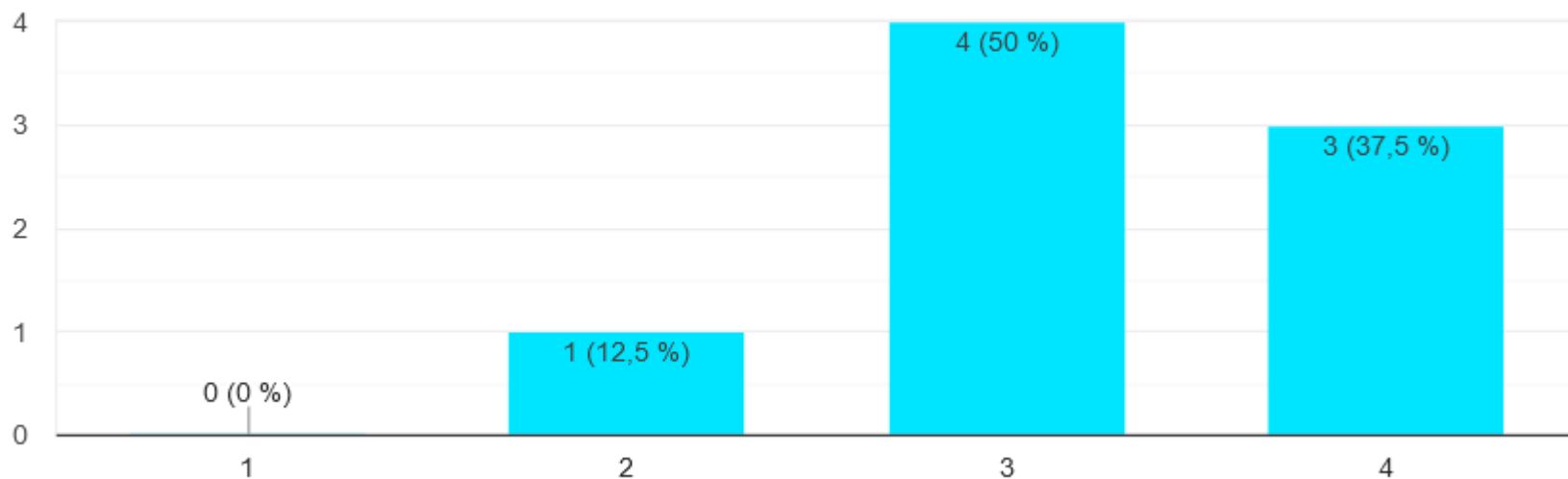

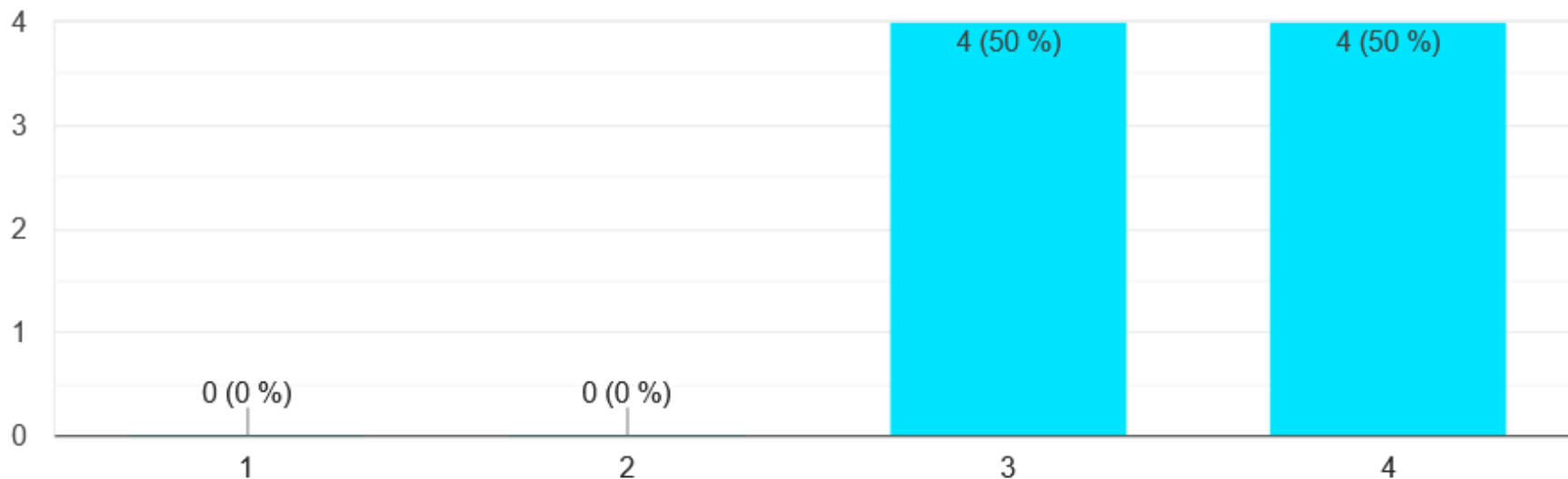
Comments: We spent considerably more time on e-learning than on WBL and F2F workshops design.

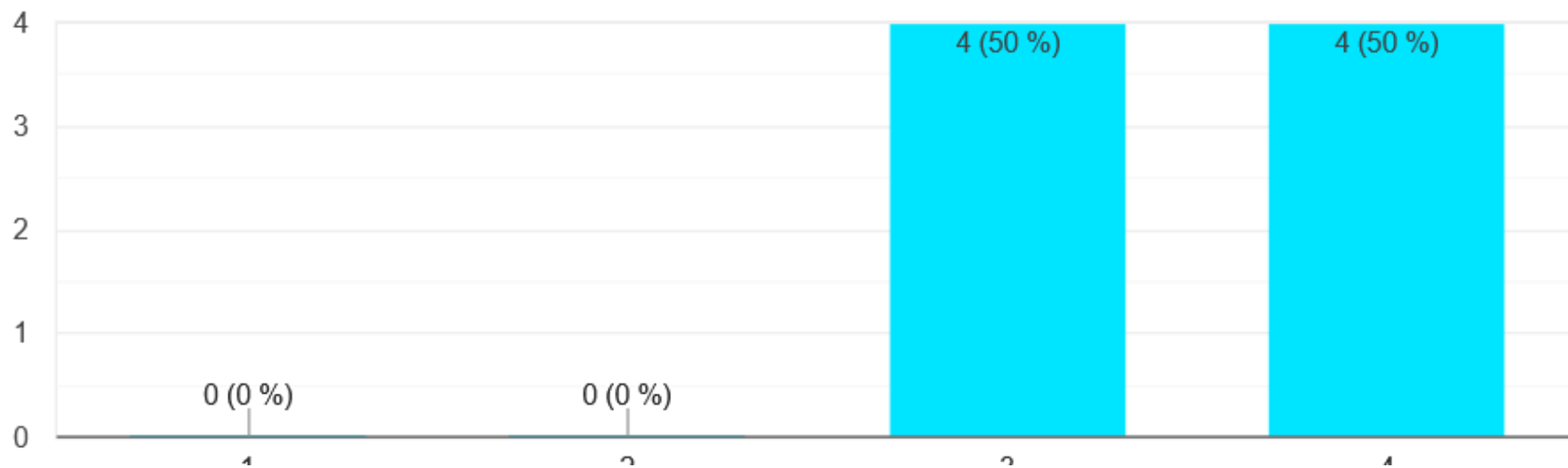

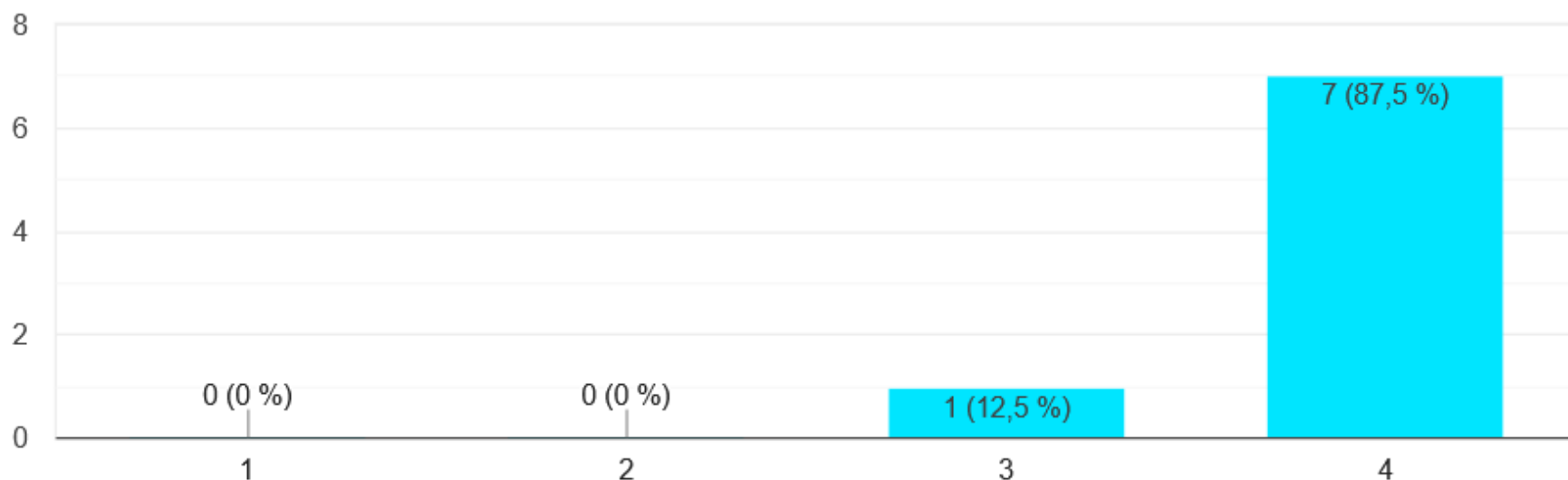

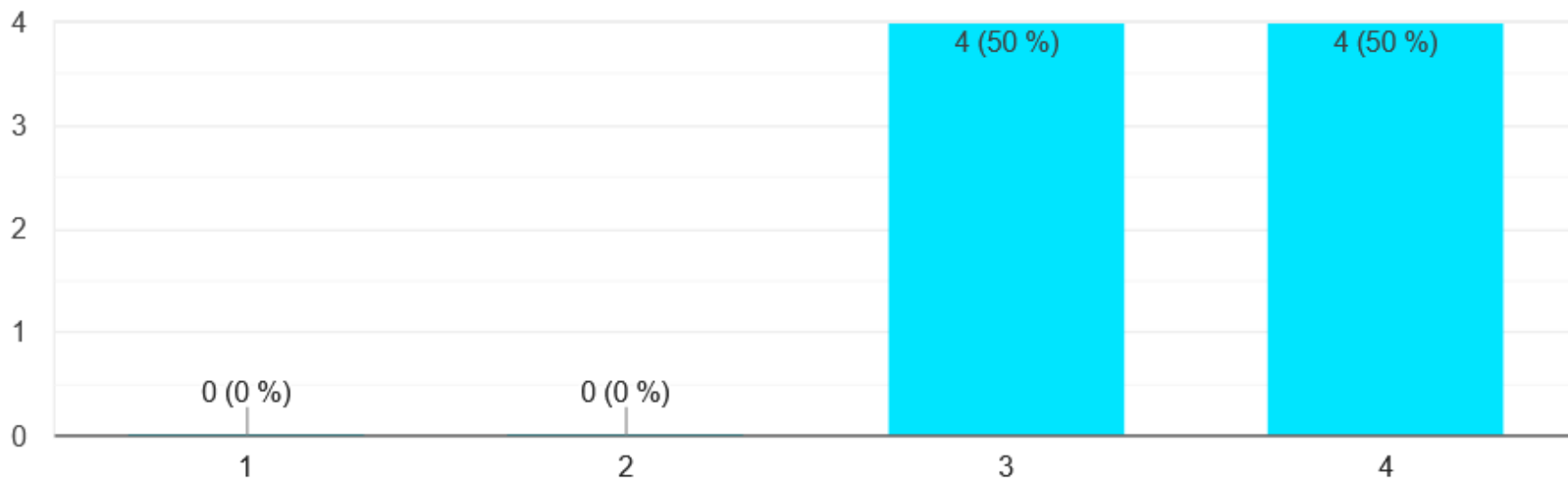

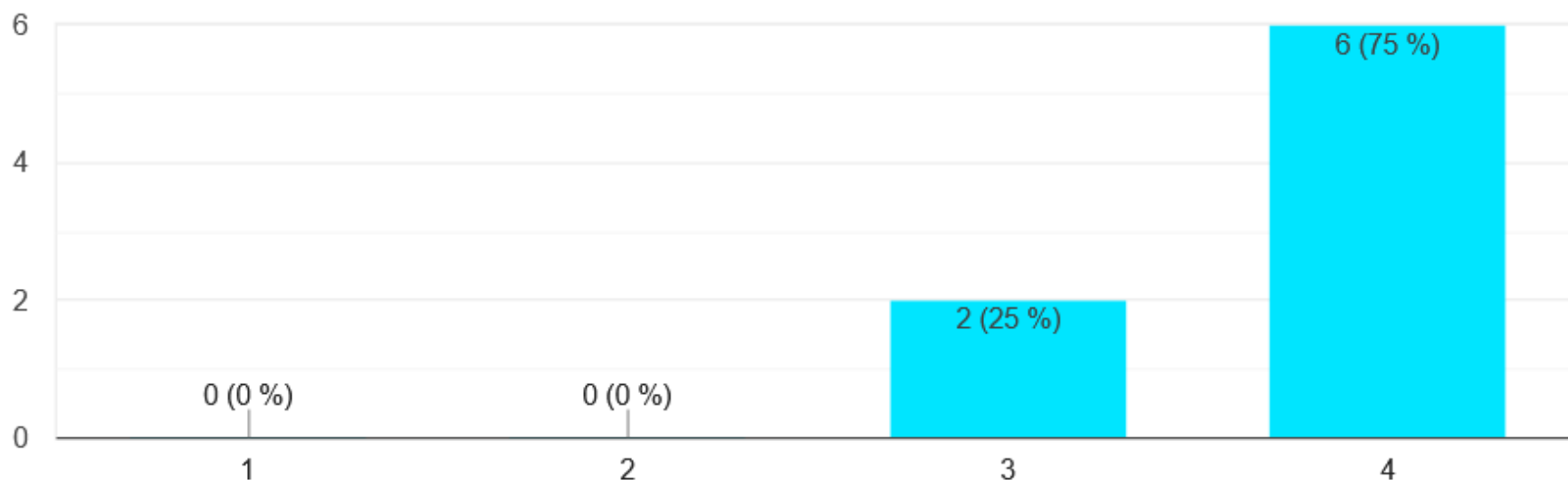
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Q10: Before the 3 days Training, did you find this meeting useful?

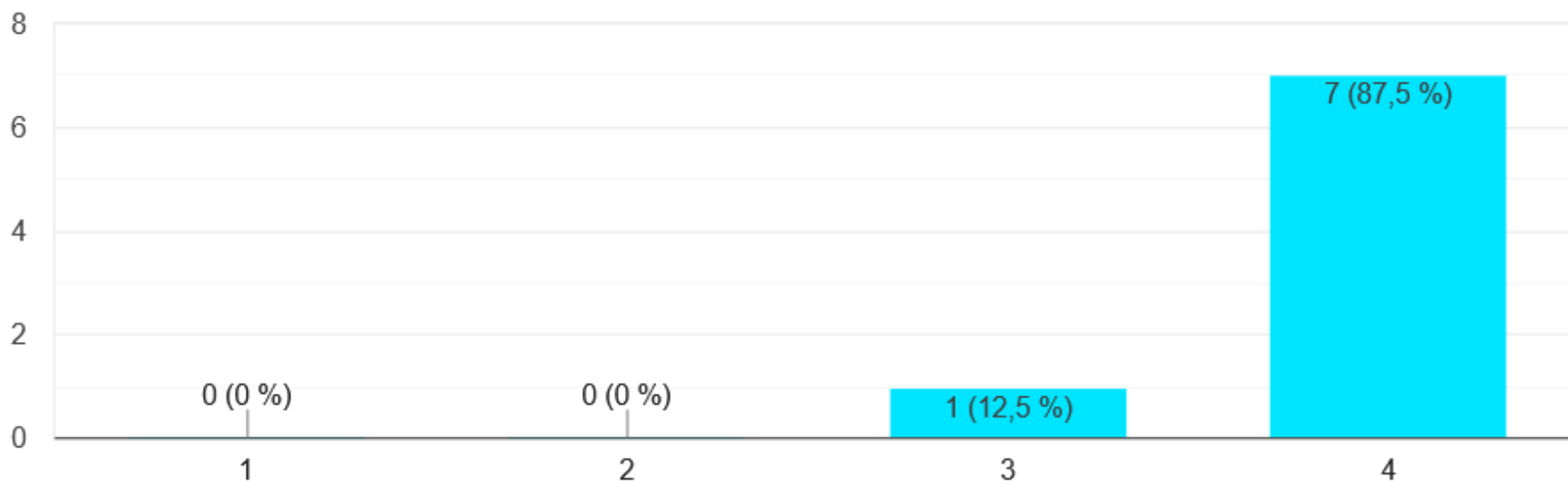

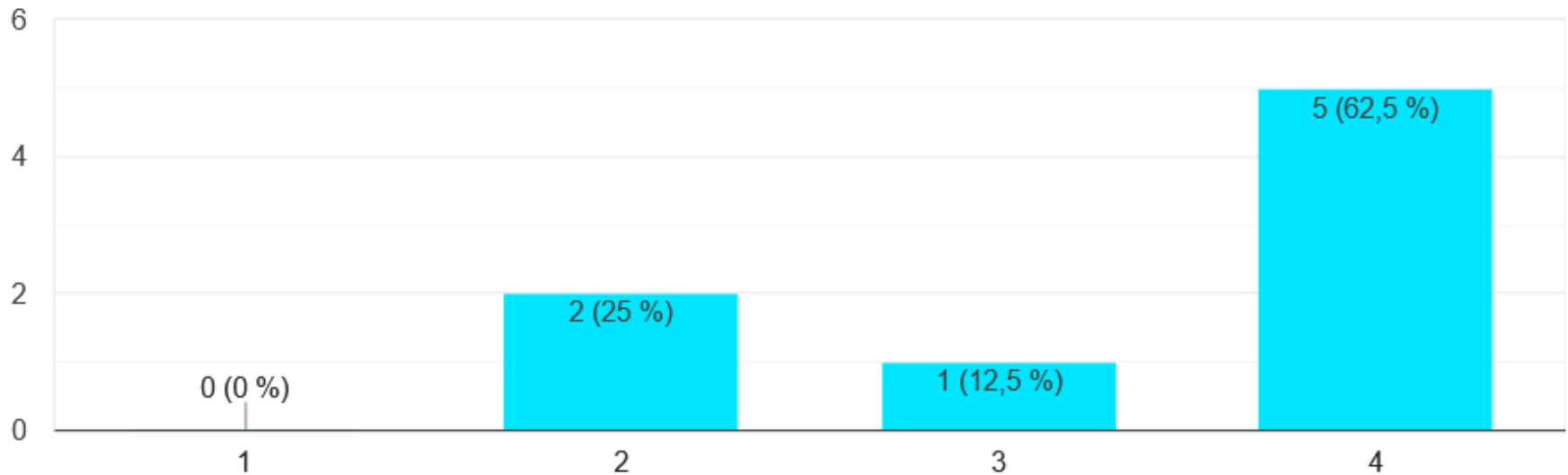

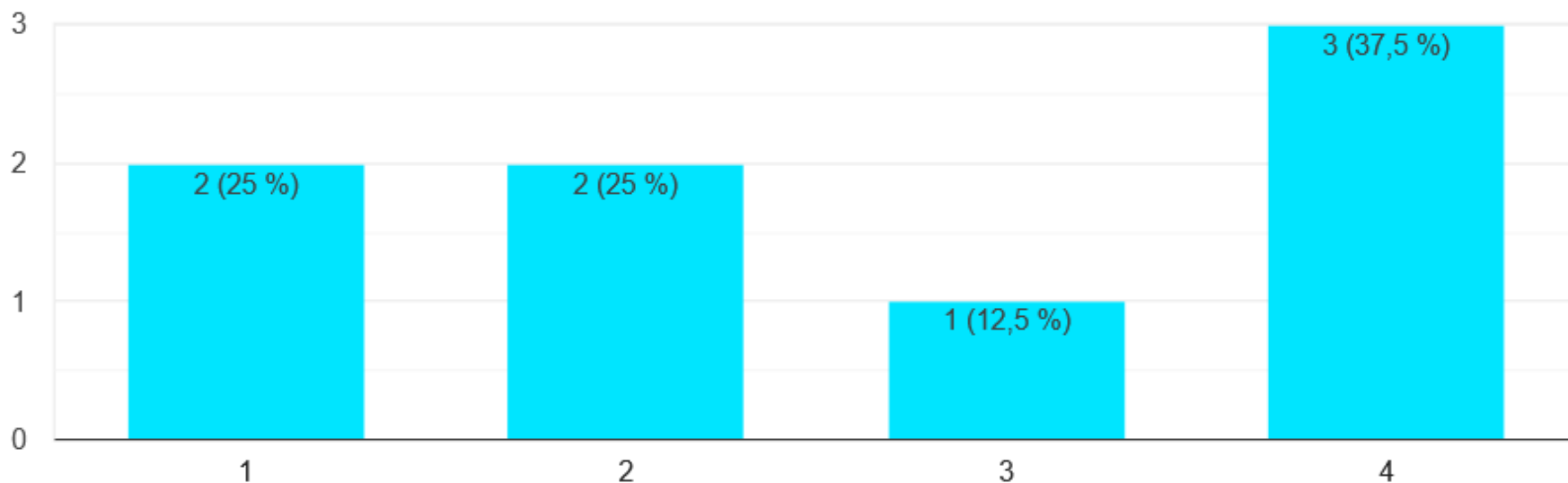
- We took major steps forward concerning pilot trainings, but the commitment to dissemination seems limited. It may get better once deliverables near completion.

Q14: Comments

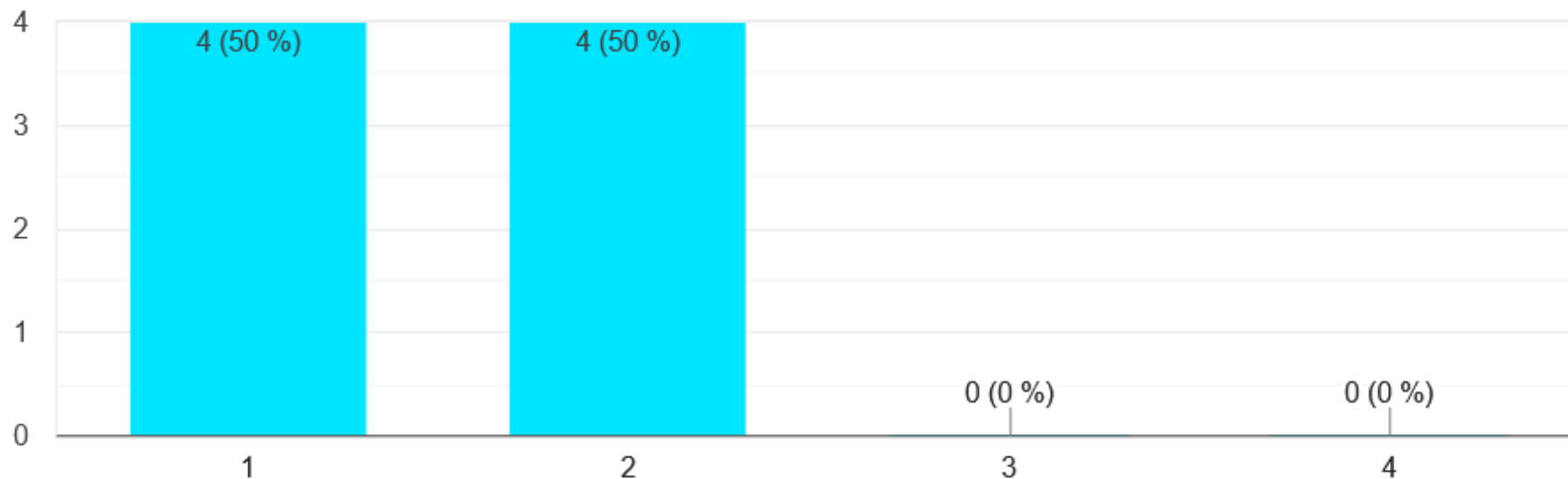
- A Teams-Meeting would have achieved less than 10% of the face-to-face output.
- Positive for the review and content alignment of deliverables, and marginally for the pilot trainings.
- Discussion in the face-to-face mode is much more efficient, less time-consuming, followed by actions. It is easier to understand different points of view. The only challenge was that not all the Partners could be present in Udine (I believe that for them it was quite difficult to follow the discussion).

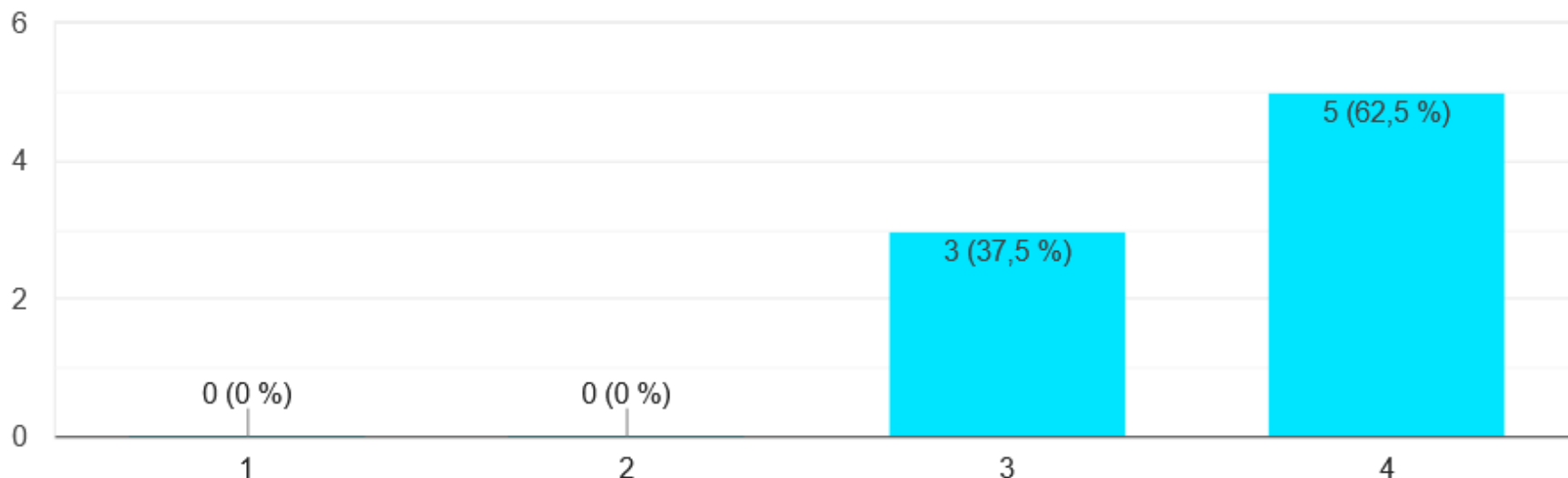
