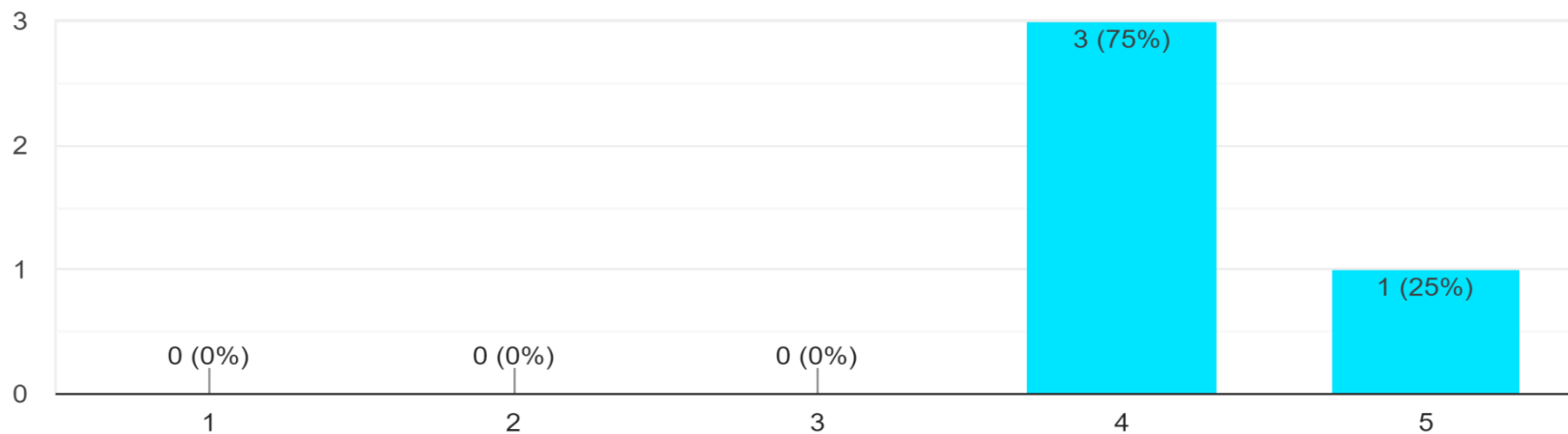

- tailoring the framework for SMEs

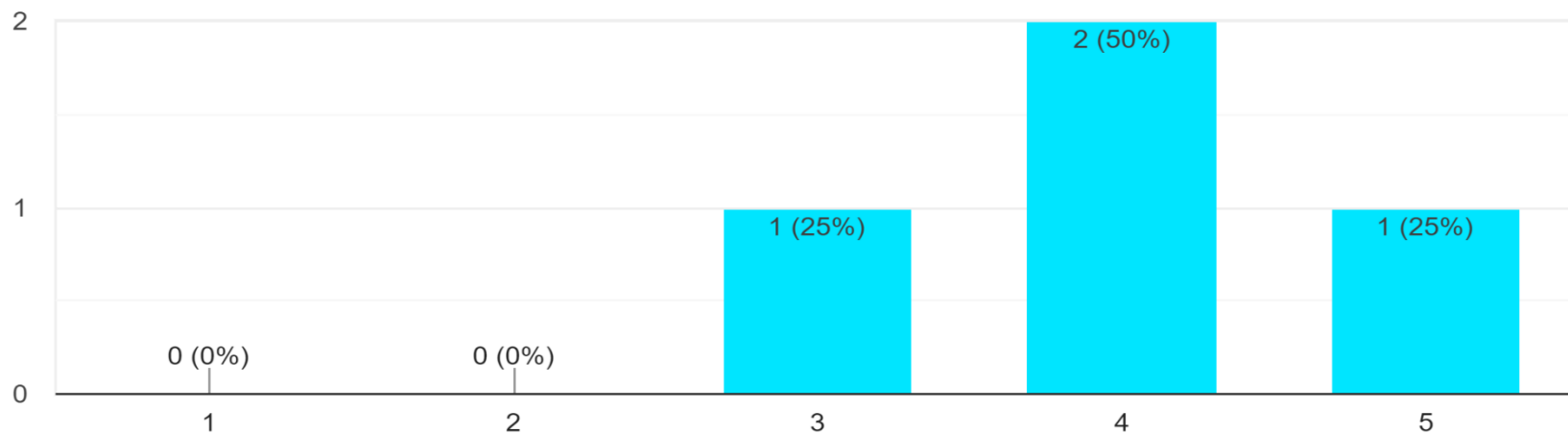




### Q3: Did the IR Framework for SMEs cover your previous expectations?

## Q4: If your expectations weren't covered, please describe your own expectations about the IR Framework for SMEs

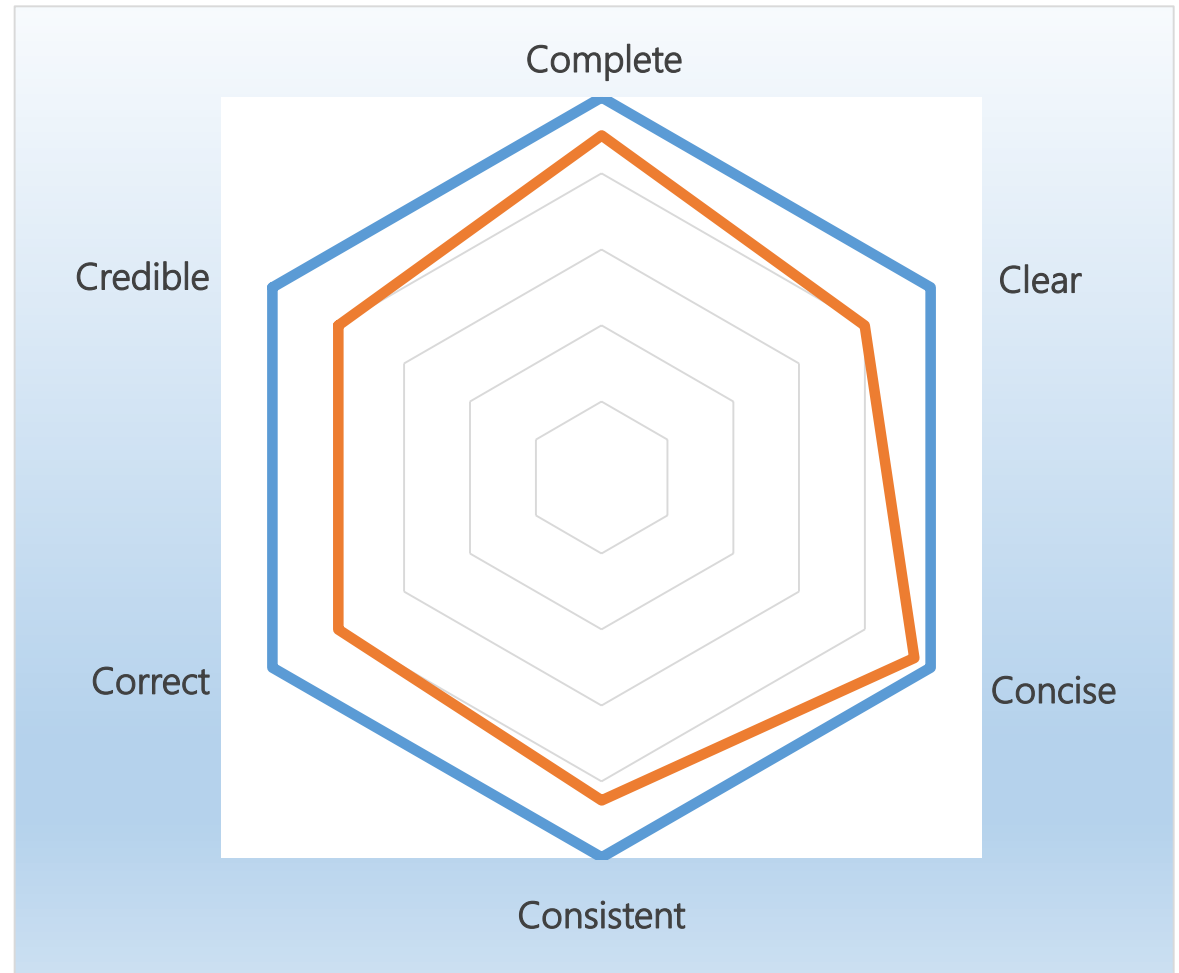
